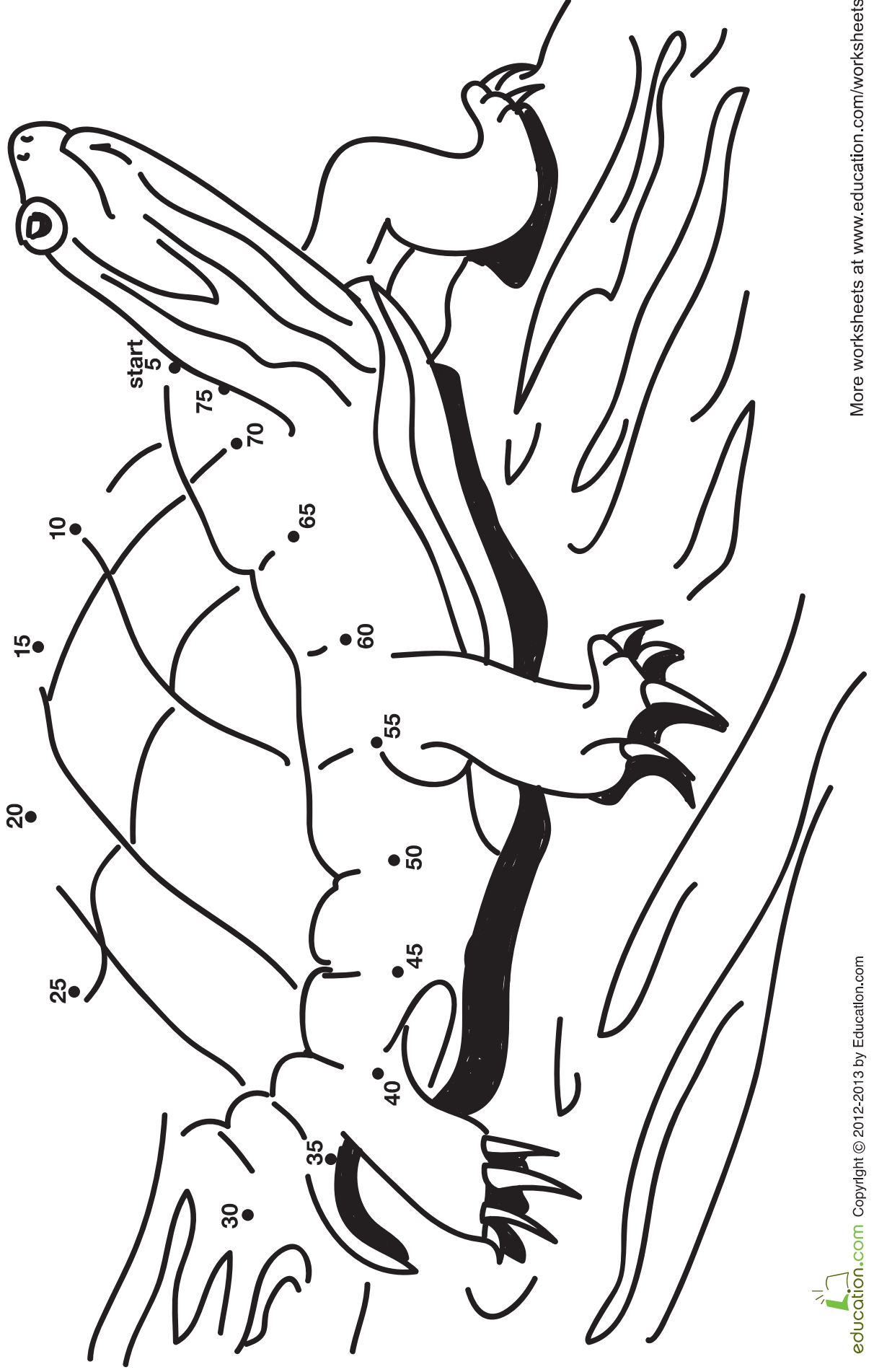

All of these dots are multiples of three. Will you connect them to create the turtle's shell?



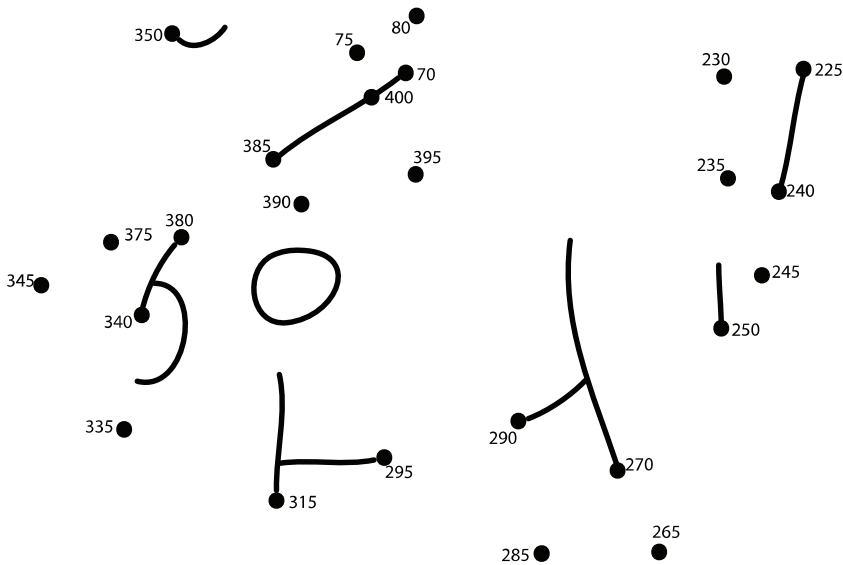
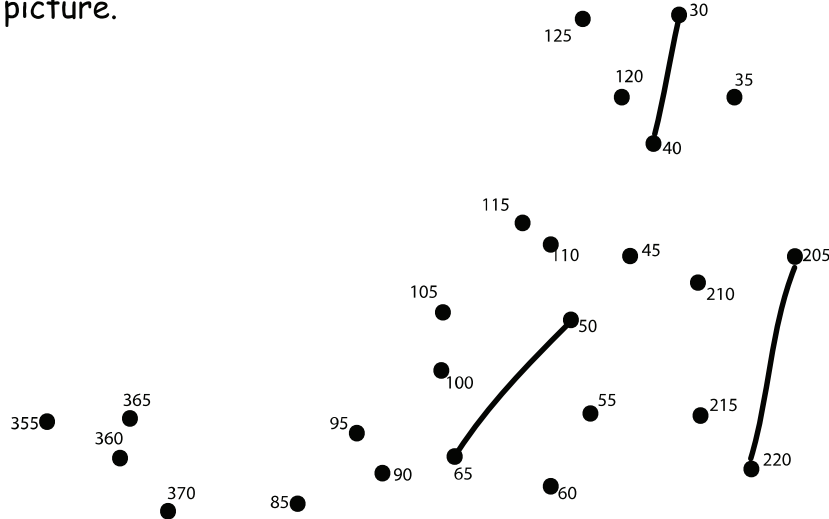
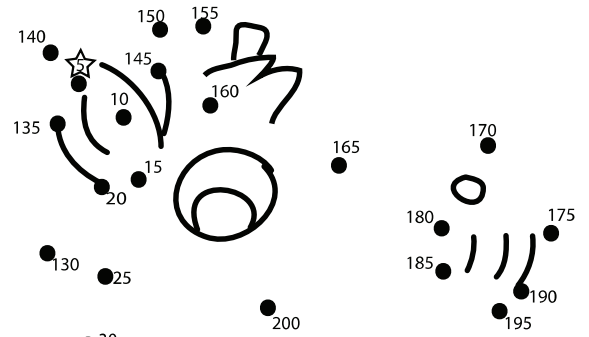
# Connect the Dots: Practice Skip Counting by Fours!

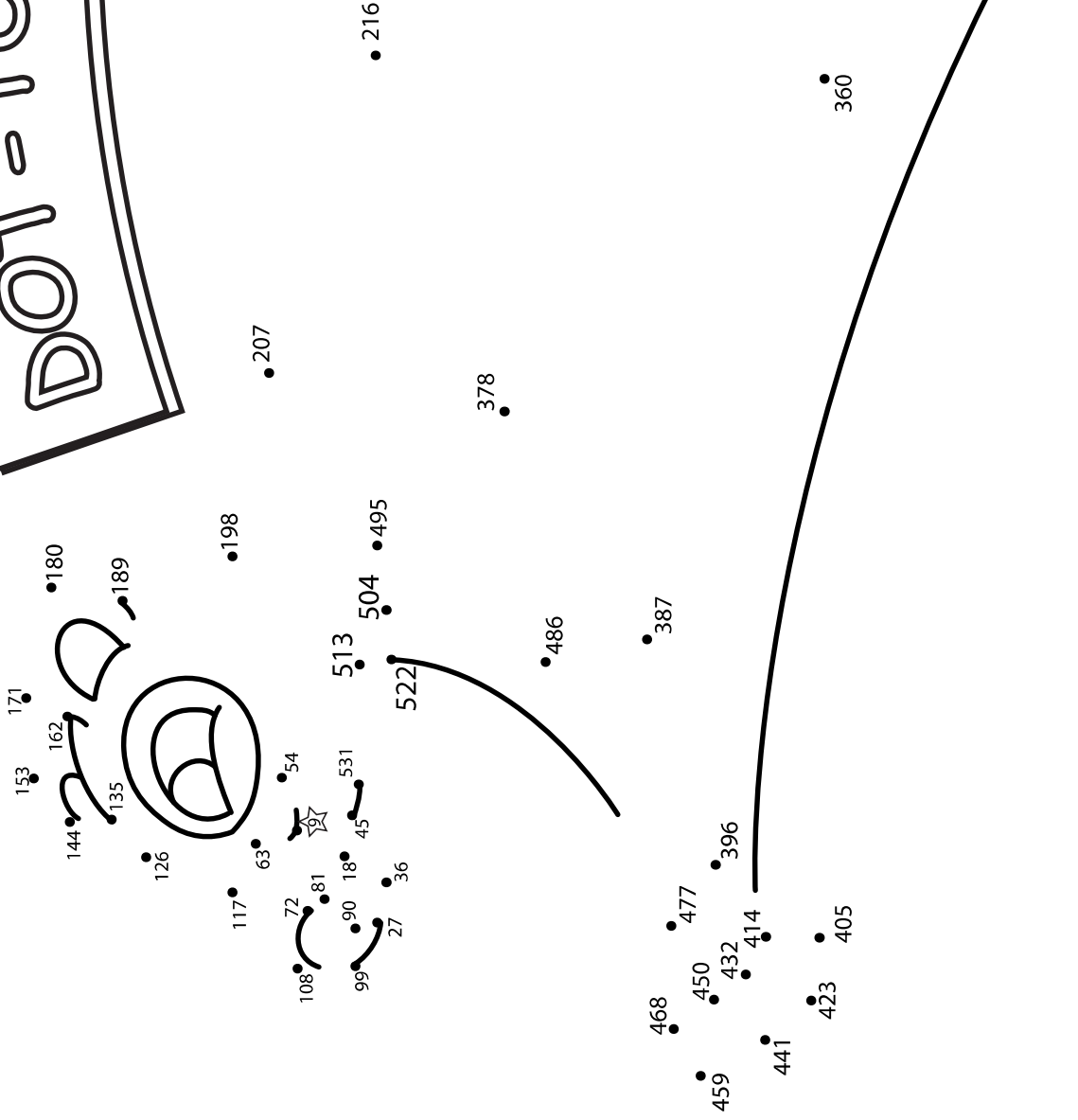


# DOT-TO-DOT ZOO

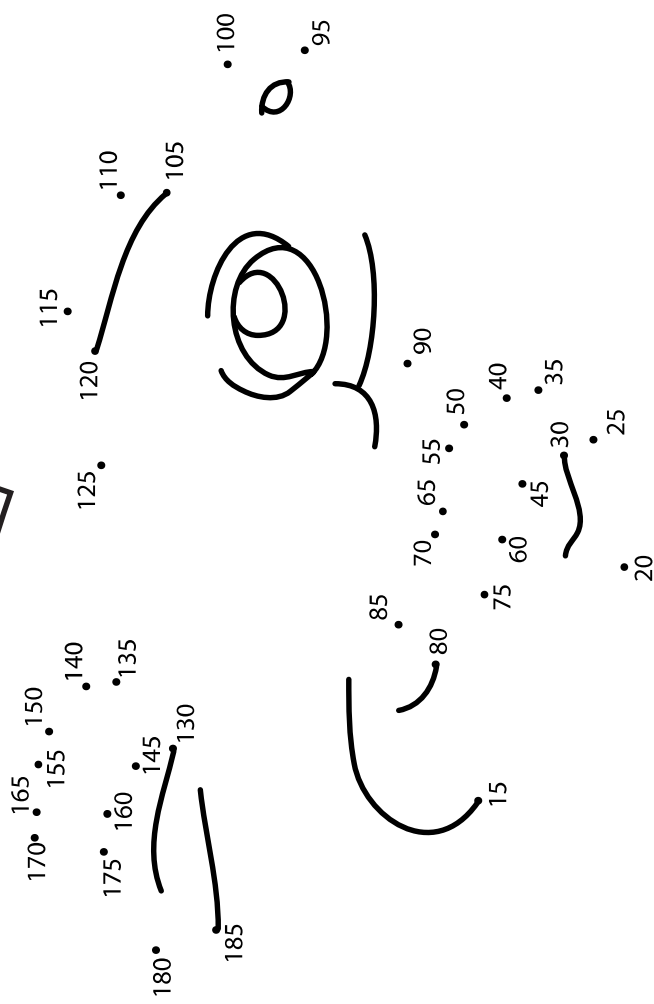

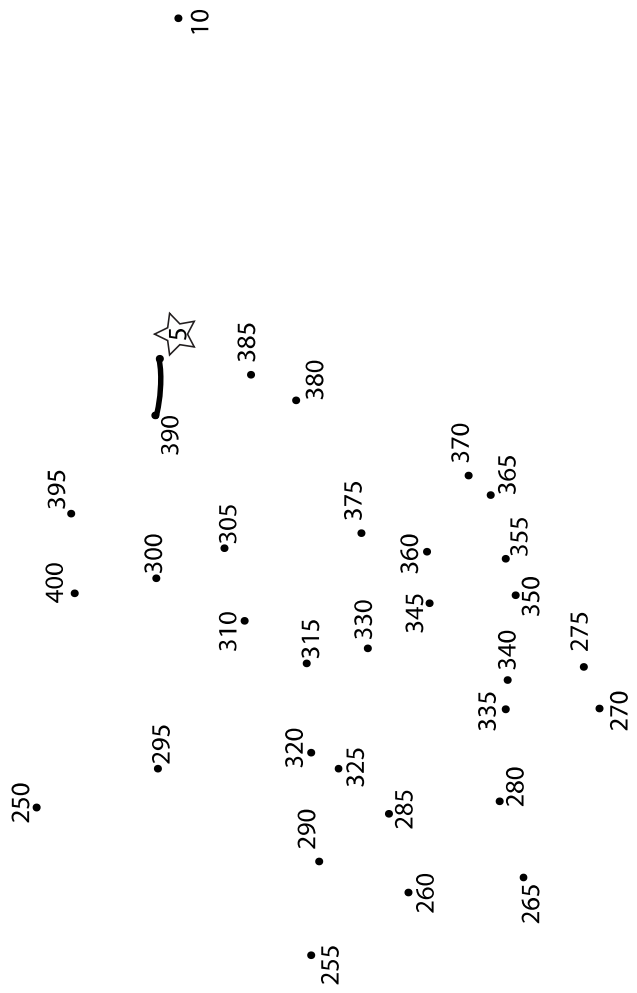
